Notice of Public Hearing

Hennepin County

Hennepin County has established a public hearing on *Tuesday, October 2, 2018 at 1:30 p.m.*, during the Public Works Committee meeting of the Hennepin County Board of Commissioners in the Board Room (A-2400) of the Hennepin County Government Center, 300 Sixth Street, Minneapolis, MN 55487.

The purpose of the meeting will be to receive comment on proposed revisions to Ordinance 13 regarding recycling by residents, businesses, and other waste generators.

Proposed revisions include:

- Requirements for cities to offer organics recycling service available to all households with curbside recycling service.
- Updates to the multifamily recycling requirements to add service level standards and education and labeling requirements.
- Requirements for businesses that generate large quantities of food waste to implement food waste recycling.
- Incorporate state recycling requirements for businesses and add service level standards and labeling requirements.
