Hennepin County's priority population of residents with housing gaps, as identified with the prioritization algorithm, February 2018

- People with severe substance use disorders who use withdrawal management (detoxification) services more than 5 times per year.
- People with developmental disabilities and *either*:
 - co-occurring mental illnesses or substance use disorders, *or*
 - needing to move from group settings to more independent living to make room for those needing more intensive care
- Youth in and leaving extended foster care
- Unaccompanied minors experiencing homelessness
- People with disabilities and level 3 predatory offenses
- People experiencing chronic homelessness (staying in emergency shelter or a place not meant for human habitation for at least a year – or repeatedly – while struggling with a disability)
- Youth experiencing sexual exploitation
- People with complex medical conditions and currently homeless
- Youth with neuro-diverse brain disorders
- People with serious and persistent mental illness and leaving treatment
- Families involved or at risk of involvement with Child Protection
